Applicants must also provide these materials for consideration:

(1) A personal essay describing why he or she has chosen to study journalism, and what the student would like to do with their journalistic skills after graduation. Essay length: approximately 500 words.

(2) Two letters of reference describing the applicant's suitability for the journalism programme and their potential as a journalist. (Please do not ask journalism professors to write these letters. Their evaluations are part of the selection process).

(3) Two samples of written work of a journalistic nature. Class assignments and unpublished manuscripts are acceptable, though published material is strongly preferred. (Publications may be print or internet-based, and they may be amateur, student, or professional).
